PCHELA SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM

The Bulgarian Education and Culture Society Pchela Scholarship Program awards scholarships to primary, middle and high school students who have demonstrated outstanding effort to promote traditional Bulgarian culture in their community and schools.

Applicants Must:

1. Be residents of Los Angeles and Orange County, California
2. Be a in grades 1-12 as of June 1, 2021
3. Demonstrate ambition and motivation to educate school peers and the community about traditional Bulgarian culture
4. Submit completed application to BECS Pchela by June 1, 2021.

TIMELINE

June 1, 2021: Student application deadline

September 15, 2021: Judging results announced

November 1, 2021: Den Na Narodni Buditeli Awards Ceremony

AWARDS

Three (3) students, to be known as “**Pchelicki**” will be selected to receive \$250 awards to be used towards school expenses. Awards are not renewable. Presentation of awards is scheduled for **Den na Narodni Buditely on November 1, 2021.**

Eligible students may receive only one “**PCHELA**” award every two years.

CRITERIA

Applicants are asked to describe in two essays why education about traditional Bulgarian culture is important to them and the content of their presentation. Use of Bulgarian alphabet and language is highly encouraged. Essays to be maximum of 300 words each and explain the following:

1. Main elements of their presentation and how it will be done.
2. To whom will be presented and expected impact.
3. Are there any aids and materials that will be made by the applicant.

The Scholarship Committee of Bulgarian Education and Culture Society Pchela will make the selection of scholarship recipients. Selection will not discriminate on the basis of race, color, religion, age, gender, national origin, or disability.

To apply for the scholarship, fill out all appropriate information in the scholarship application and then complete the essays on the following pages. No purchase necessary to apply.

Applications and required attachments must be received no later than **June 1, 2021**. All applications that have met the deadline will be considered. Applicants are responsible for gathering and submitting all required information in the format requested. Incomplete applications and those not conforming to the required format will be disqualified. Information received is considered confidential and is reviewed only by Scholarship Committee and Bulgarian Education and Culture Society Pchela Board of Directors.

If selected to receive an award, the student must authorize release of scholarship application materials and photographs for use by Bulgarian Education and Culture Society Pchela or its sponsors for promotion and publicity.

All award recipients will be notified by **September 15, 2021**. Not all applicants to the program will be selected as recipients.

DISTRIBUTION OF THE AWARDS

Bulgarian Education and Culture Society Pchela will process the **PCHELA** scholarship award distributions. Distributions will be made in full in the Fall of 2021.

Checks will be made payable directly to the recipient for payment of educational expenses.

OBLIGATIONS

Other than as specified, recipients have no obligation to Bulgarian Education and Culture Society Pchela. Applicants are, however, required to supply Pchela with any changes of address, school enrollment, or other relevant information. See **RULES** for more information.

Eligibility

No purchase necessary. Board members, employees, associates, or immediate family members of board members, employees or associates of Bulgarian Education and Culture Society Pchela are ineligible to apply.

Application

All sections of the application form and any attachments must be completed in the specified format and include the required signatures. Incomplete applications will be disqualified. Pchela will not be responsible for lost, late or misdirected, mutilated, incomplete, illegible, or postage-due mail. All applications become the property of Bulgarian Education and Culture Society Pchela and will not be returned or acknowledged. Bulgarian Education and Culture Society Pchela may request additional information or documentation about an applicant. To remain eligible, applicants must provide a reasonably requested documentation and information. All entries must be either typed or legibly hand written.

Awards

Awards must be used for education-related expenses of the applicant. Awards will be paid in full in the Fall of 2021. Taxes, if any, are the sole responsibility of the recipients.

Additional Terms

All applicants agree that decisions of Bulgarian Education and Culture Society Pchela are final. To receive the award, recipients agree to authorize release of scholarship application materials and photographs for use by Pchela or sponsors for promotion and publicity. Applicants agree to release, discharge, and hold harmless Bulgarian Education and Culture Society Pchela from any and all claims or damages arising out of, in any way, their participation in the program. Pchela reserves the right to review the conditions

and procedures of this scholarship program and to make changes at any time, including termination of the program.
